PBS Authorities – Changes to digital access July 2023

We understand having access to PBS-subsidised medicines can be critical to patient care. That's why Services Australia and the Department of Health and Aged Care are continuing to work together to increase the number of PBS medicines that can be requested and approved in 'real-time' using the Online PBS Authorities system (the system). This includes the recent changes made to the juvenile idiopathic arthritis medicines from 1 July 2023.

These changes will make it easier for you to request authority approval for these medicines from Services Australia. You will no longer need to submit hard copy authority applications, prescriptions and test results. Instead, you will be able to use the system to apply for authority approval and provide evidence digitally.

The PBS Authority Required application forms for these medicines will reflect the requirements for digital submission.

Alternatively, applications for authority to prescribe can be submitted online using the form upload facility in Health Professional Online Services (HPOS) at www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/hpos

If you're using the authority application form via post or Health Professional Online Service (HPOS) form upload facility, you'll still need to submit authority applications, prescriptions and test result details. This will delay the assessment of the authority application.

Can PBS authority applications be submitted by post?

You can still submit applications for authority to prescribe by:

- mailing your application
- uploading documents in HPOS.

Updated versions of application forms will remain available on our website.
